



Ideas to Increase Engagement!

- <u>Dress Down Day</u>: Donate X amount of dollars or bring in a certain number of food items and you may wear casual attire
- <u>Potluck Day</u>: Bring in a dish for lunch! In order to gain entrance, you must bring a certain number of food items or pay an admission fee
- <u>Food Theme Day</u>: Challenge co-workers to bring in as many different food items as possible in a certain category. For example, food geared towards people with diabetes, or food for children in a particular age group.
 Whoever has the most different types of food within the category wins a prize
- <u>Prize/Reward</u>: Have a prize for all employees who participate if your company wins their category or overall event- maybe a company t-shirt for all staff? Give a reward to staff who donate more than 20 cans or \$100
- <u>Totals</u>: Display weekly or daily totals in high-traffic areas; announce totals using email or newsletter to keep people up to date and involved
- <u>Friendly Competition</u>: Conduct non-monetary waging and/or email wars between law firms and/or firm sections
- <u>Client solicitations</u>: Share your local food bank story and ask for donations
 via Facebook, LinkedIn, email and or in person
- Bake sales
- <u>Silent Auction</u>: Ask staff to make item donations then auctioning them off over a period of time
